### *Hospitality at the Heart of the Gospel*

All Adults of Saint Andrew, Saint Francis of Assisi, and Saint Paul the Apostle: Mark your calendars now for the Parish Mission to be held **March 25-28!** Our presenter will be Lonni Collins Pratt, a nationally known speaker and author on the topic. The basic program will be in three parts, Sunday, Monday and Wednesday evenings beginning with Mass at 7:00 pm, followed by the presentation which ends at 9:00 pm. The Tuesday evening session, held at the same time will begin with Mass in Spanish and include an overview presentation on these in Spanish and English. All of the sessions will be held at Saint Paul the Apostle in Seneca. On Monday, March 26, there will be Mass at noon at Saint Francis of Assisi, followed by a “box lunch”, followed by an overview presentation.

If you sometimes say, “I don’t get anything out of Mass,” then ask yourself, “Then what am I *bringing* to Mass?” Prepare for Mass by fasting for one hour before receiving the Eucharist, by pondering the Scripture readings, by praying before coming to church, and by being attired appropriately for supper with the King. Remember, the Mass is no ordinary religious service. It is an ancient journey from our ordinary world into the supernatural world of the Sacred Trinity!
