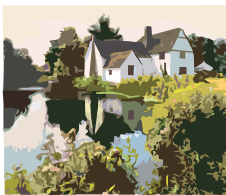

Pastoral Council From Don Fuller, President

At the last Pastoral Council meeting, September 6, a number of very important subjects which affect the Parish's future were reviewed and we had lengthy discussions on all of them. The subjects were: the survey results from the Town Meetings, Father West's newsletter to the Parish, the Pastoral Council Elections for 2012, new members, the Parish Youth fundraiser, new offices at Saint Paul's for Father West, Sister Joan and Lynn Sexton, the status of on-going studies concerning the development of a Parish Disaster Plan and a complete review of the Parish Ministries program.

Reports were submitted by the Communications Committee, Stewardship Committee, Saint Francis Committee, Social Justice Committee, Youth Formation Committee and the Liturgy Committee. As you can see we had a very complete and long working meeting that generated discussion on critical Parish topics.

1. The Town Meetings survey results: Consensus on the need to acquire land (71%) and the Town Meeting agenda & presentations (74%). Agreement by a majority was not reached on the location of a new Saint Andrew Church and the financial support for a new Saint Andrew Church.
2. A Nominating Committee for the PC elections of three new members was selected and they are Steve Finger, Martha Davenport and Chris DesMarais.
3. The K of C council 6884 has agreed to raise funds for the Parish Youth Program. The first fundraiser will be a Western Dinner Dance on October 15 at Papineau Hall.
4. The Stewardship Committee is in the process of updating the Stewardship Opportunities brochure and also reported that the Parish has 54 new families registered since April 2011.
5. Father West announced that the Parish newsletter was ready and he shared its content:

The message is STEWARDSHIP and the critical issue of Parish income vs. expenses. Income needs to be increased and Father will suggest a 3% tithing immediately from all Parish families and individuals. If income from collections does not increase to match expenses, the Parish will be required to start reducing expenses in order to balance the yearly budgets for 2011 & 2012.

Please let your PC members know your thoughts on all that was discussed.
